

BEGINNING IN MARCH 2020 and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our four Twin Cities locations reduced levels of capacity to help ensure the safety of families. Because of this necessary step, the number of families served in 2020 is lower than in previous years.

Our services remained at 100%. Although we paused our 10,000-strong volunteer program, including Cooks for Kids, we provided three complimentary meals a day to families at all locations. Families report that these meals are the most important service we provide.
